Dear Parent/Carer,

We are looking forward to celebrating results day with all of Year 11 on Thursday 22nd August. Please arrive between 10am and 12pm at the College gate (Gate 3) and results will be issued in our College Study Centre.

Students are able to request a review of marking from exam boards if they are unhappy with their grades or they are close to a grade boundary. However, the exam boards charge for this service and all fees must be met by the student/ parent. Fees can range between £40-£60 per exam paper depending on the exam board. As a school, to help students come to a decision of whether to request a review, if a student gives us permission to view their exam paper(s) we will ask a member of teaching staff to look over the paper(s) to try and help the student/ parent come to a decision about whether to request a review. This will not happen until staff return in September and we cannot guarantee that we will be able to see all papers before the review deadline. It is also worth noting that there is no guarantee that a review will see marks improve as they may also go down.

Full details of post results services, including reviews of marking will be available on our website before results day.

Students will then have the opportunity to discuss their next steps with our Careers Team and Sixth Form Team. We will also be asking all students to complete a destination survey as this helps us to inform our future planning and support.

Appointments have been booked for enrolment to Sigma Sixth on Thursday 22nd and Friday 23rd August. The Sigma Sixth team will be available in the College Cafe, so you can register immediately instead of waiting for your appointment if you want to.
